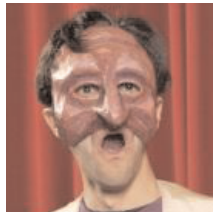
STANJ Blast 1: Friday, April 8th Due Date for STANJ Spring Conference:
